## Annual Gathering of the Geriatric Oncology Professionals on 25-27 October 2012 in Manchester

The 12<sup>th</sup> annual International Society of Geriatric Oncology (SIOG) meeting will be held on 25-27 October 2012 in Manchester, United Kingdom. This annual gathering is the leading conference for experts in the fields of oncology and geriatrics. Its purpose is to foster the development of health professionals specializing in geriatric oncology, in order to optimize treatment of older adults with cancer.

More than 300 professionals will be attending the meeting; including scientists and physicians in the fields of oncology and geriatrics, nurses, nurse practitioners, and health professionals who are interested in and or involved in the management of older patients with cancer.

Authors of proffered papers will also be invited to present their abstracts at the event. The submission deadline for the abstracts is 1<sup>st</sup> August.
